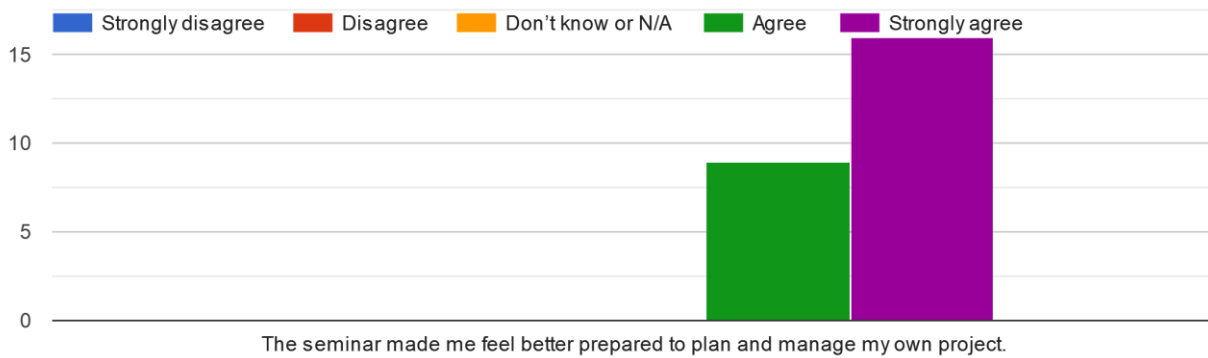
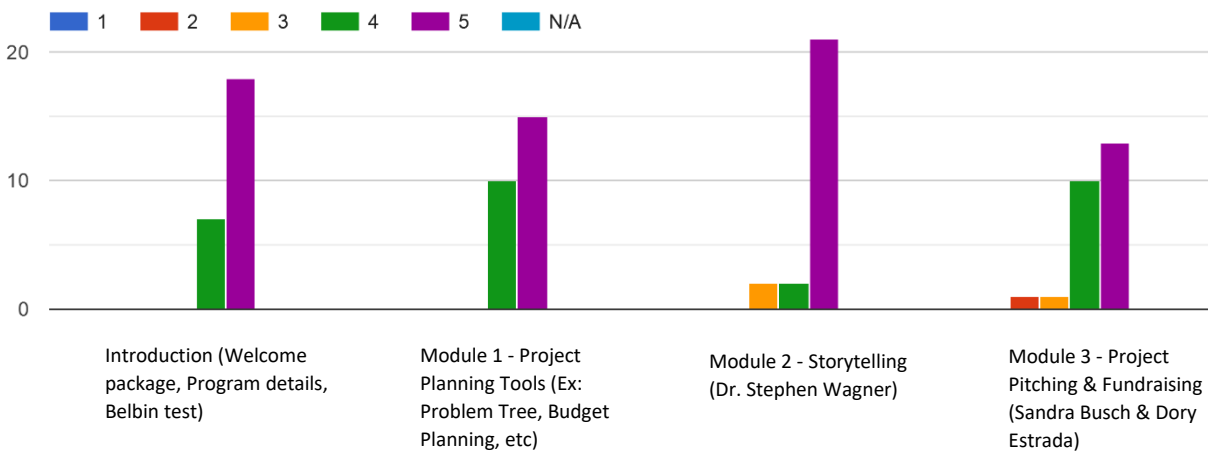

Comments on Learning Modules Evaluation

Would probably be a 5 for all, if we had had a bit more time :)

The tool training was interesting but I wish the projects we worked on were more researched before starting working on them, also that we had more interactive learning rather than pre recorded videos. Also the fundraising was a bit disappointing because I expected proposal writing and how to apply for funding from external parties rather than selling stuff on the street.

Some Weltweit videos could use an "upgrade", because they are a bit hard to follow (technical issues and rhythm/script)

The workshop was strong in the project planning tools as we got to practice and discuss in groups and the material was well prepared in advance. The Storytelling seemed to be disorganized at the beginning, but it improved as long as we advanced. Module 3 was good, but the topic is complex to be covered in a few hours.

It was overwhelming in the first two modules and would be great to have it in three days.



Even though the last part was very enriching for being a space of experience - sharing, I have notice that it was not very much about learning or managing tools or developing soft skills needed when it comes to face the fire while dealing with fundraisers. This because by concentrating us in one particular experience (like the one with Sandra) can lead to a bias understanding of the concepts and the way to deal also with big actors.

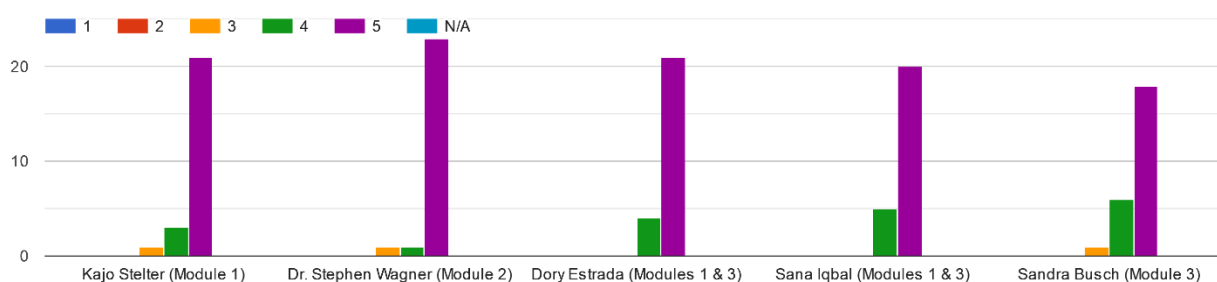
The formulation of the workshop was very well planned, even in short time duration we managed to work on the topic.

some of the explanations were not clear especially on budget planning exercise



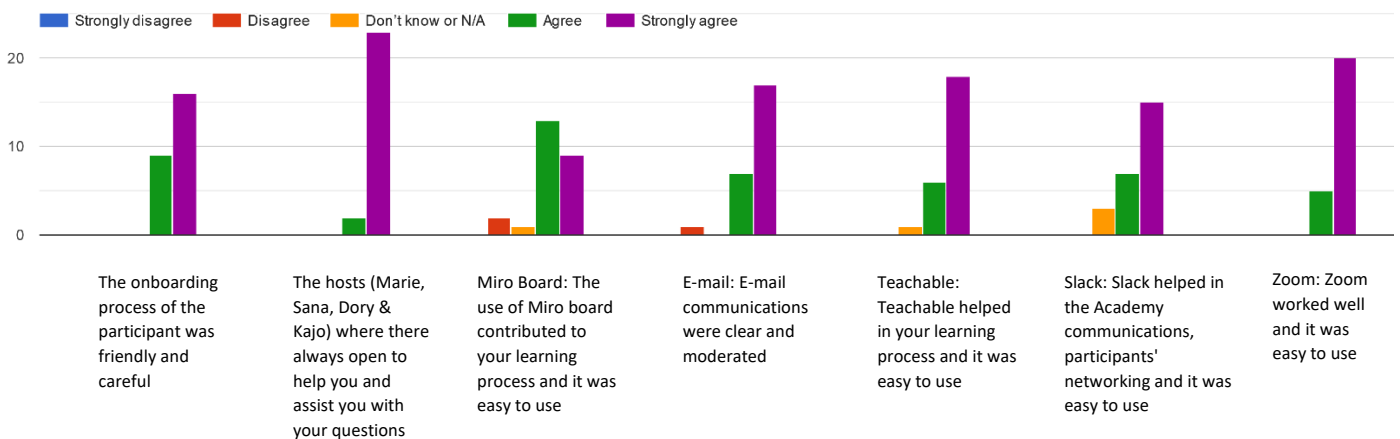

For the future when it comes to the selection of projects, maybe before the first day the team would be asked to write a little needs assessment report for the area or a small situational analysis so that all team members are on the same page when it comes to the region they are working in since every person comes from a part of the world. Also if we can practice writing a concept paper or applying for a real fund then it would be top.

It would have been interesting to talk a little about how the teamwork in the groups went.

I suggest that the invitation to the workshop for potential participants to have enough time to develop the project proposal and research more about certain details of the project to be embarked upon.

In my opinion the most relevant challenge of PM is to have mechanisms to solve conflicts among participants. Otherwise is very difficult to achieve a logical and well structured project, and it has a 100% chances to failure. I it would be nice to incorporate at the beginning a space to discuss this issue (how to work in a team in a professional way), because dealing with people and being able to reach reasonable agreements is the true challenge here. The project is secondary.
