	2. Meeting with the community based organization (CBO).
	3. Monitoring of already done grafting.
	4. Meeting with consultant to plan activities and timeline for the
	plantation of olive plants in the nursery.
	5. Meeting with consultant for preparing agenda and modalities
	for farmers training scheduled in June 2022.
	6. Removing bottlenecks (if any).
Key Activities/ Outcomes of the Visit	1. Admin of the SWP met with office bearers of CBO for the
	project related activities.
	2. After that formal proceeding were started. The already done
	grafting (3,000 in number) were monitored by the consultant
	and found satisfactory.
	3. It was agreed that two days activity will be conducted day as
	per detail given below: -
	a. Day One: Delivering training to farmers on grafting
	techniques by the consultant
	b. Day Two: Delivering training on plantation techniques
	4. Keeping in view the availability of local community and
	weather forecast, it was decided that these two days training activities
	will be conducted on 11 th and 12 th June 2022.
	5. The security and water issues, already pointed out in the
	previous meeting were resolved by the local community. It was decided
	that each owner of plants shall install fencing/barbed wire in his



respective area for the security of olive plants from grazing animals and human interference.

6. Moreover, the concerned owner shall also provide water to his respective plants through his own arrangements.
