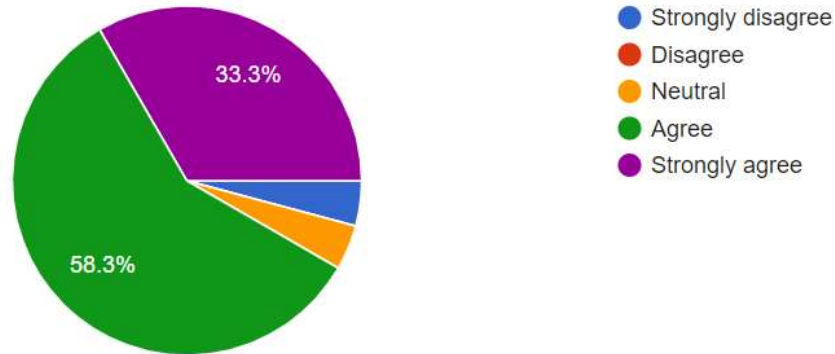


## General Evaluation

Having attended this workshop, I know the basic rules within the most common methods of fundraising. I feel able to design a fundraising strategy for my own project or start-up.



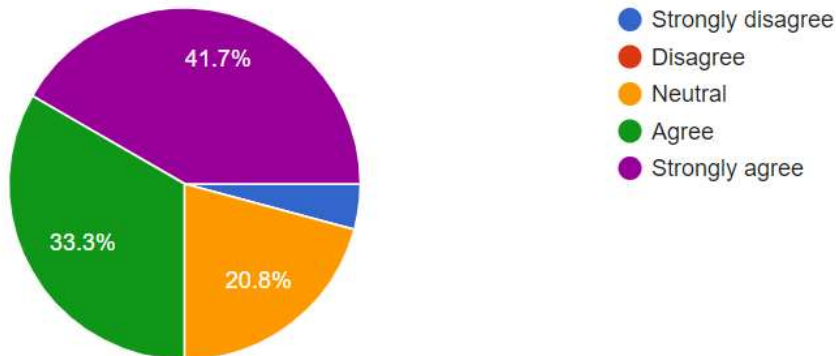

Having joined the Action Network Platform and attended the workshop, I have expanded my professional and/or academic network.

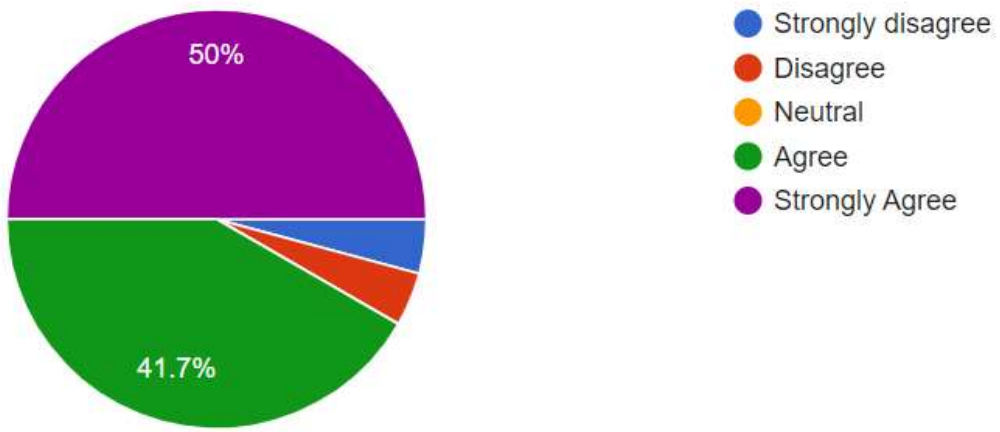

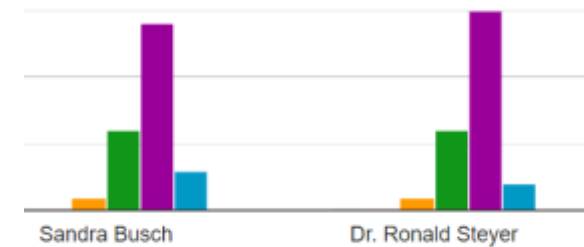
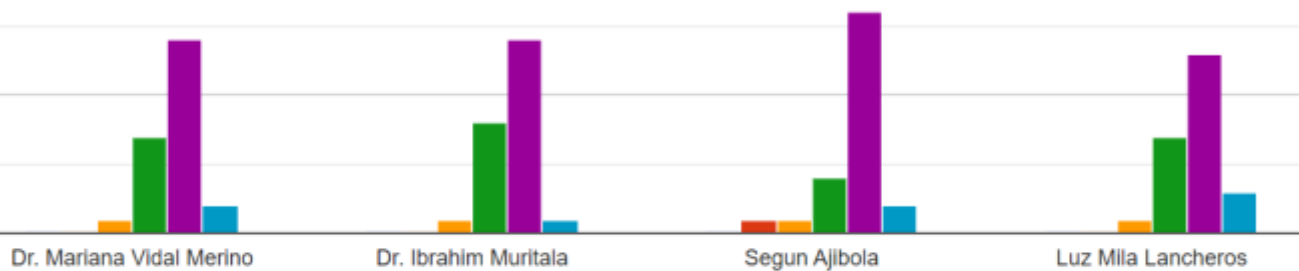
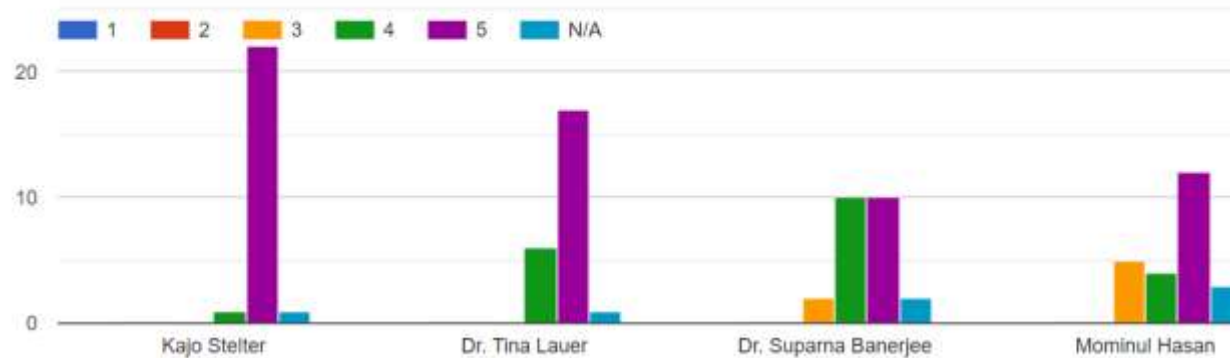
The sessions were informative and educational. In comparison to before the class, they helped me feel more capable and confident about fund raising.

All the instructors were very committed and professional. Accept my deep admiration.

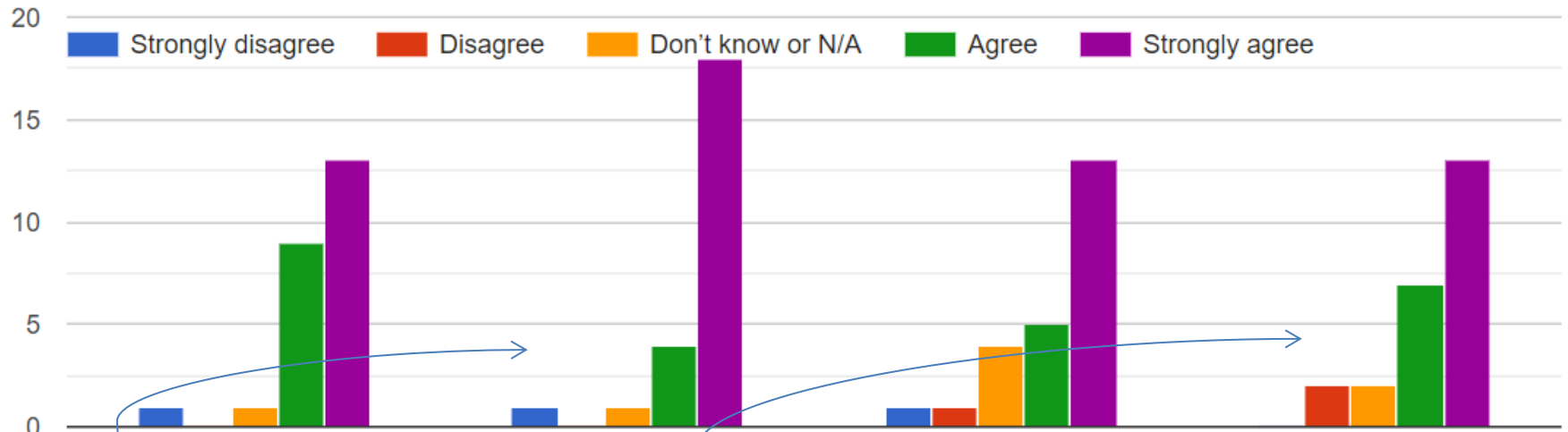

# Hosts, Systems and Learning Platform Evaluation



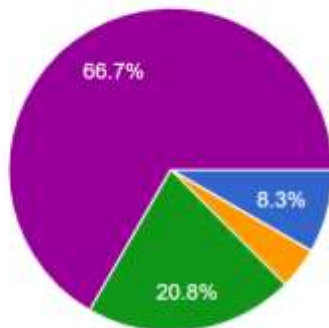
The onboarding process of the participant was friendly and careful.: E-mail communications were clear and moderated.
