


2. Quality of the learning content

I gained a lot from this course. I would recommend it to others.

The material was relevant and the resource people knowledgeable. However, I felt that in some cases some more case-specific guidance and feedback would have been useful to help keep control of the understanding and progress on each module. Not all participants had the same level of familiarity with such tools, or some projects were more complex than others, therefore some might need a bit more personalized assistance. The sessions were rather long, which could have allowed for more guided group work, but most of the case the plenary discussion took too long (and a lot of it was waiting for the participants to join and catching up at the beginning).

Project Planning & Storytelling - the designer perspective aspects of the workshop did not have direct connection to the social projects so i will suggest that it should be structured such that we can have direct understanding of how to use the tool in such a social projects.

I think all the modules had an interesting perspective for us to learn, and I liked the exercises and passion from the presenters

- 4) lastly, it would be great if you would make provision to fund at least the best idea. That




would ensure and encourage active participation and ehance the competitiveness of the members to strive to achieve more.

Time management during the sessions. More time should have been allocated for guided group work and iterative feedback in order to progress with the material in a more homogenous way and making sure we are understanding most of the tools, instead of being stuck in some and having to skip others.

I liked the specific feedback we got in each step, and in the final presentation, it helps us understand where there is room for improvement and which are our strengths as project managers. I hope you can find a way to keep the participants in the entire process, because more people can learn from all of this, maybe get more involved in the groups distribution and organization (or just make sure everyone has a team or something to work on, and even adapt to less projects but with a stronger team). Maybe have shorter sessions (like three days a week but shorter sessions 1.5 or 2 hrs sessions, and/or a shorter break, like 15 minutes), since sometimes I felt a bit overwhelmed with the time and mental energy needed for the modules. I appreciate how the presenters wanted to give all the useful information, and how they focused on the most important exercises. Overall, I enjoyed it, learned new things, and found it helpful, so keep it up!

Too many tools were shared for our use on MIRO... while they are all very good and important, and while sharing more, gives us the option to pick those that appeal to us, it was at times confusing to wade through the not-so-friendly MIRO in search of what one needed. Perhaps we only receive the tools we are to use on the program. Reference can then be made to where many more can be found.

I think the sessions could have more time in-between so that we have more time to process the info of one session before the next one. I really liked the networking. And I also liked all the tools, but specially the UX Design ones: Julia is very didactic

I like sticky notes in Miro. However, it would be good if Miro was more user-friendly. Some features could be improved: 1/ Zoom in and zoom out. Sometimes I cannot do with the mouse and do not know why. 2/ Dragging feature to the workplace could be improved. For example it would be faster if there was a small window showing the overall Miro board besides the main board. If users want to go to their workplace, they just need to use the mouse to point to locate it and click on the small window.
