





DIGITAL COURSE

SUSTAINABLE FINANCE AND IMPACT INVESTING COURSE

PROGRAM

The seminar introduces the participating students to concepts and materials in sustainable finance and impact investing while strengthening their knowledge and participation in the network of global impact investment.

It will take place on **Action Network Worldwide**, an online platform (LMS), and **Zoom**. Participants will go through one introduction module and four content modules.

The training will be developed through the **project-based learning methodology**, since at the beginning of the training, working groups will be created and assigned a project with the objective of applying what they have learnt during the week in the project.

Methodology

The participants will need to dedicate a total of three hours and a half per week, two committed to asynchronous work in the digital platform and the other one and a half to participate in the virtual calls that will take place on Thursday afternoons. During these calls, the participants will have a chance to meet with experts in the topics, discuss some of the material received during the week, and develop different activities to encourage the network within the participants.

Requirements to obtain the certificate

- Attend at least 3 of the 4 group calls. There will be one call each week and its length will be 1.5 hours.
- Participate in the weekly activities that will be found online
- at the end of the contents of each module.
- Deliver the final project and other deliveries.
