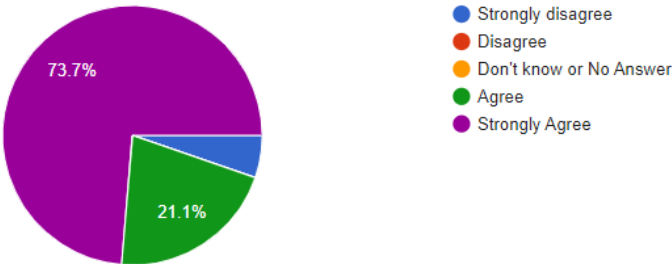


Summary of Participants` Evaluation „Summer Academy 2024“

1. The overall "impact" of the seminar

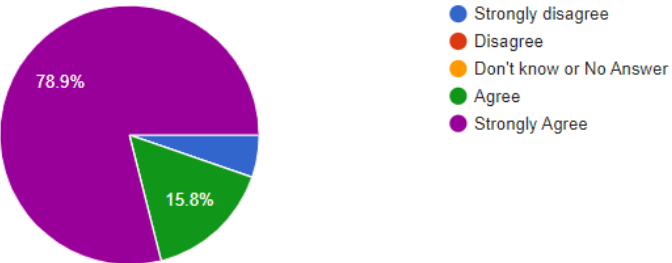
"I am now able to design and present a project plan with the help of the learned methods better than before the seminar."

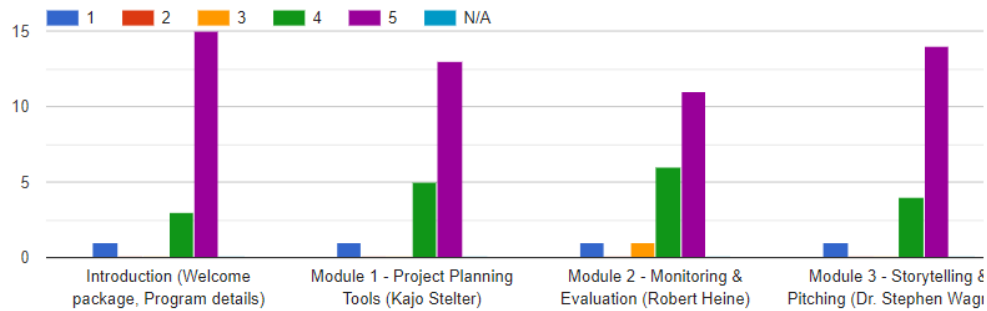

Very good quality of lectures, nicely presented and also very highly qualified for this specific context of development aid

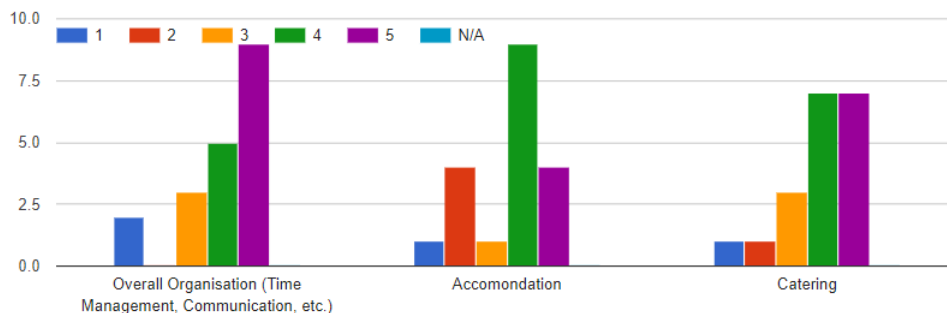
All modules were good for me but i think the Evaluation day became a little boring and hard to catch up because of the complex slides and many other things. It should be reduced to important parts only. And more group work

Now to the improvement, time management could be a better. Although it's understandable that everything can't be done upto the minutes, and some deviations are unavoidable.

It could be better to really have fixed timing for discussing each projects, or giving feedback. Session conveyors could also be little strict to limit participants from interrupting them with long opinion sharing. Because if one participant keeps interrupting every five minutes, no matter how valuable that information is, it takes away from others opportunity to share and deflects the schedule.
